RYA SRC Radio Course – Run over 1 day, this course is the recognised course to obtain your VHF licence, which is valid world-wide and for life. At the end of the course is both a simple written examination and a practical test to pass. A student course pack is required and can be purchased through the club for £15.00 or can be purchased direct from the RYA web site.

Course cost £40.00.

To obtain your licence from the RYA a fee of £60 is required paid directly to the RYA.

MRSC Race Support – For those with RYA PB2 or Patrol boat duties this will be a one day bespoke course covering the basics of Race management, mark laying and dinghy rescue. Cost £10
