

MRSC Club Dinghies Use

Fees will apply when using MRSC club dinghies (excluding RYA training). The fees are listed below to cover on-going maintenance costs and payment should be made in advance by cheque to *Mengeham Rythe Sailing Club*.

Terms of Use

- 1, Dinghies can only be used by Members of the Club, who may be required to produce proof of membership and identity prior to use.
- 2, Oppies are the only dinghies available for beginners. It is required that hirers have undertaken training and are competent in sailing the dinghy they wish to hire.
3. No club dinghy will be used by the same person or family for a period in excess of 7 consecutive days.
4. The Club may require the user to provide a deposit against damage of £50 prior to use in addition to the fee.
5. At its discretion the Club may require the user to reimburse up to £50 of the cost of any damage to the dinghy or for lost equipment, fair wear and tear excepted.
6. In the event of an insurance claim arising in respect of the used boat the user will be liable to pay the excess of £50.
7. Immediately after use, the dinghy must be put back on their trolley, washed down, with all the rigging packed away correctly and stored in the junior store room. The dinghy must be covered, parked and tied down in the allocated space in the dinghy park.
8. The user may not sail the dinghy other than from the Club site without prior approval of Club RYA Principal.
9. These dinghies are for members to learn to sail and practice sailing. They are not to be used as tenders.
10. The user will inform the Junior Secretary immediately after use or as soon as possible via email to juniorsec@mengeham.org.uk of any identified faults or repairs that maybe required for the used dinghy.
